How to set up a global whistleblowing scheme

Organizations always face the risk that something will go badly wrong. Whenever this is the case, the first people to know will usually be those who work in or for the organization.

Research has shown that while 1 out of 4 employees is aware of misconduct at work, more than half (52%) of them stay silent because they fear that they have the most to lose if they speak up.

Implementing a constructive whistleblowing scheme that provides the right framework for breaking this rule of silence is therefore likely to provide the organisation with a multiple range of benefits.

Find out why whistleblowing really matters, what legal framework governs the set up of a whistleblowing scheme in Luxembourg and at European level, what decisions need to be taken within this framework and how the set up of a whistleblowing scheme can be practically managed.
